Prerequisites

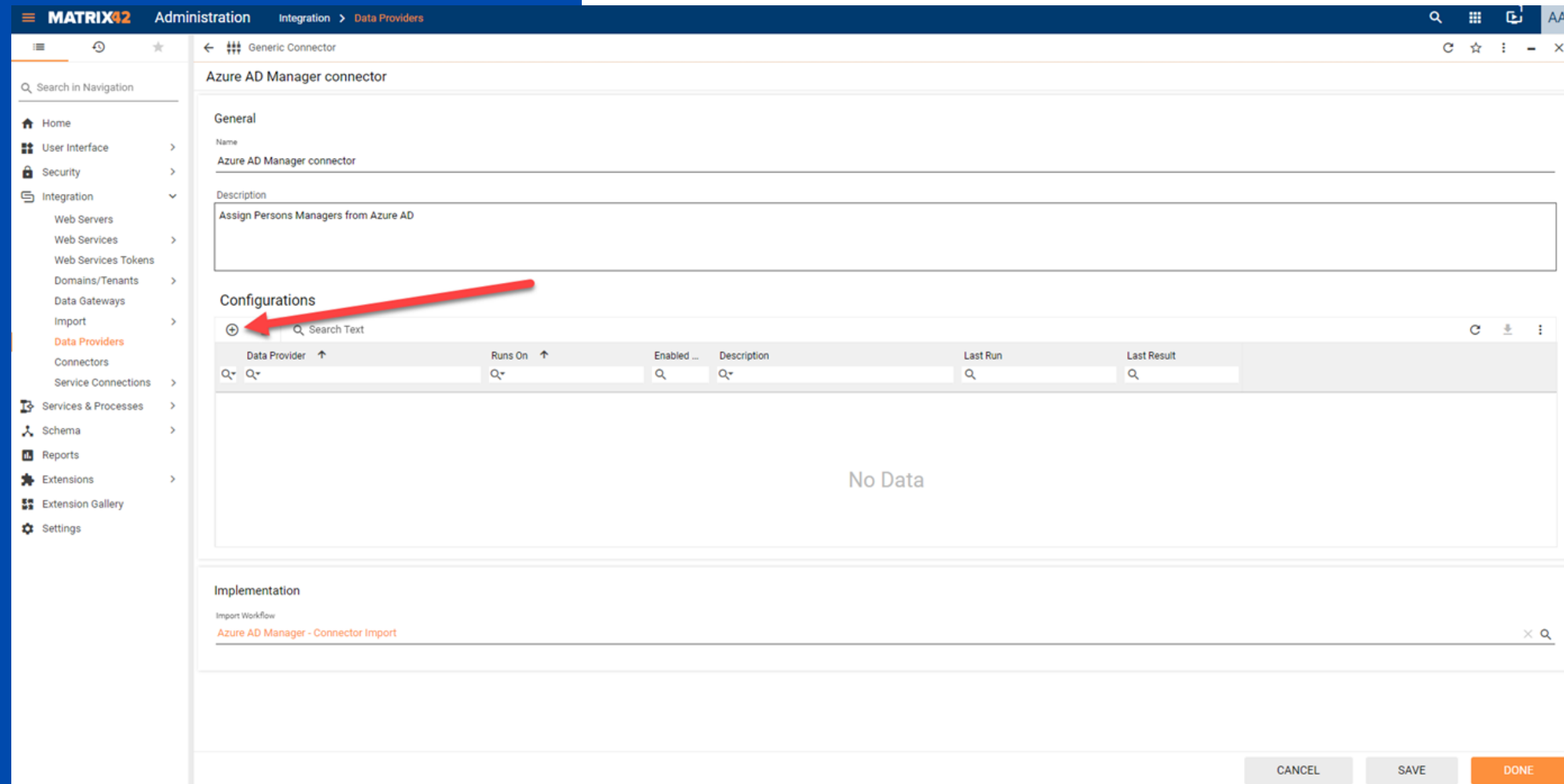
- A working Microsoft 365 service connection

- "Azure Active Directory / Office 365" Data Provider already configured and running.

Create Connector Configuration

Go to Administration > Integration > Data Providers and edit "Azure AD Manager Connector" and click "Edit"
• On the table click "+"

Setup The Configuration

On the general page make sure to fill Domain and Service Connection correctly. Check «Import Enabled» to make sure to enable the configuration. (You can also enable it later)

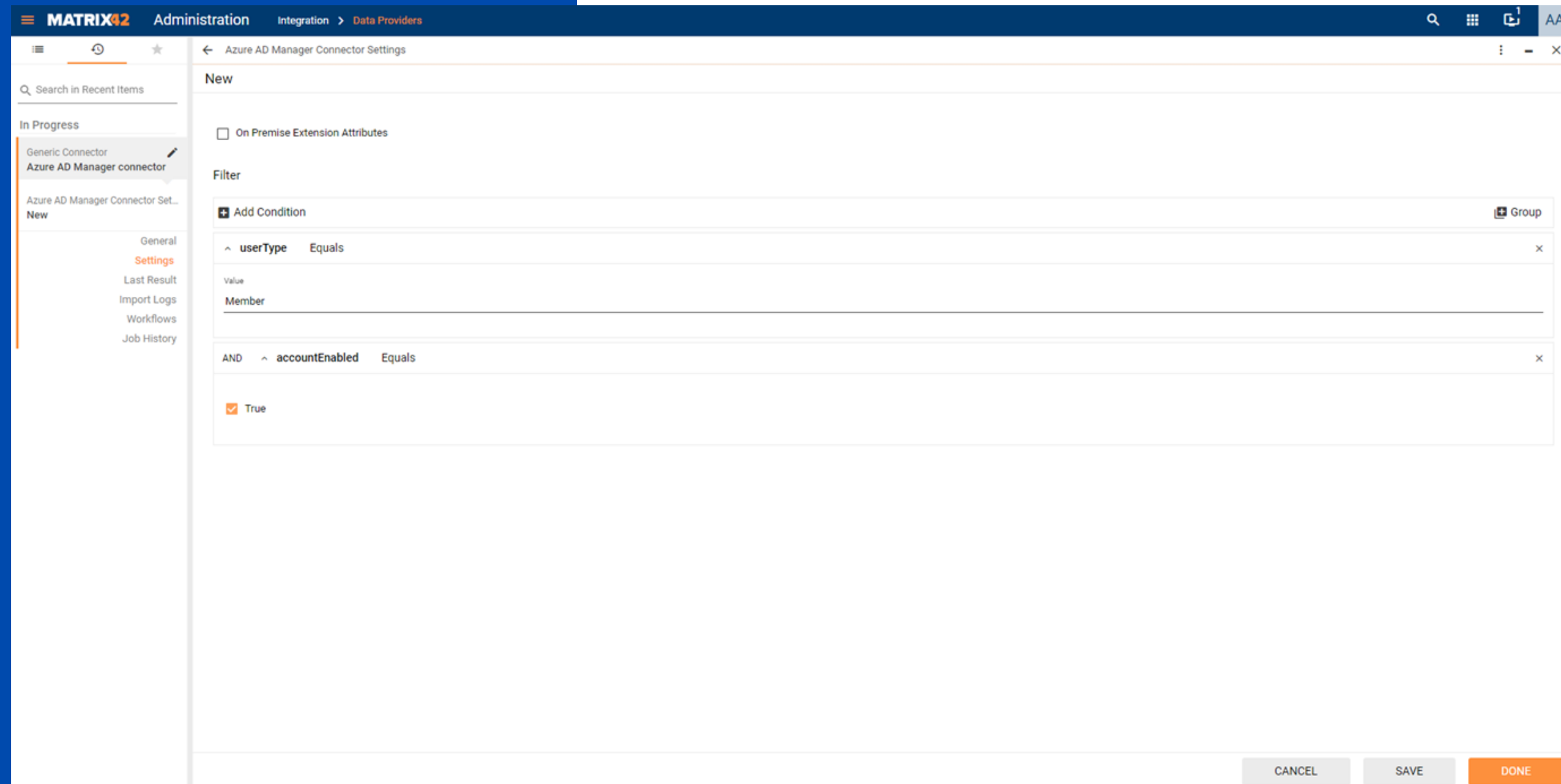

Enable the Connector

After saving the configuration, you can return to Data Providers page and enable the connector by clicking «enable» action (make sure to check «import enabled»)
